
Instructions: Compare School Spending and Student Characteristics

- Follow these instructions to use the scatterplot feature to compare school spending with student characteristics.
- First, decide whether you would like to compare school or district level spending by clicking on the appropriate button in the menu.
- These buttons will each expand to show the years of data that are available.
- Click the year you are interested in analyzing.
