Instructions for Comparing Schools

- The school level tool allows for multiple types of analysis:
 - Comparing schools within a single district.
 - Comparing schools from multiple districts.
- See the slides below for examples of each.

Example 1: Comparing Schools within a Single District

- **STEP 1:** Identify a district.
 - After you identify a district, there will be a list of all schools in the *state* in the Box labeled "STEP 2."
 - A list of schools will populate in the Select School(s) section below "STEP 2."
- You can then click the check boxes to select and unselect schools based on what you'd like to display.
- To reset and include all schools, re-check the "All" box in **STEP 2**.





Example 2: Comparing Schools Across Multiple Districts

- To compare schools across districts, select the districts in STEP 1.
- In STEP 2, uncheck the "all" checkbox.
- Click on the magnifying glass (circled in the image to the right) and type in the name of each school you'd like to display.
- Click the check boxes to select and unselect schools based on what you'd like to display.





Comparing Schools Across Districts
