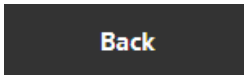
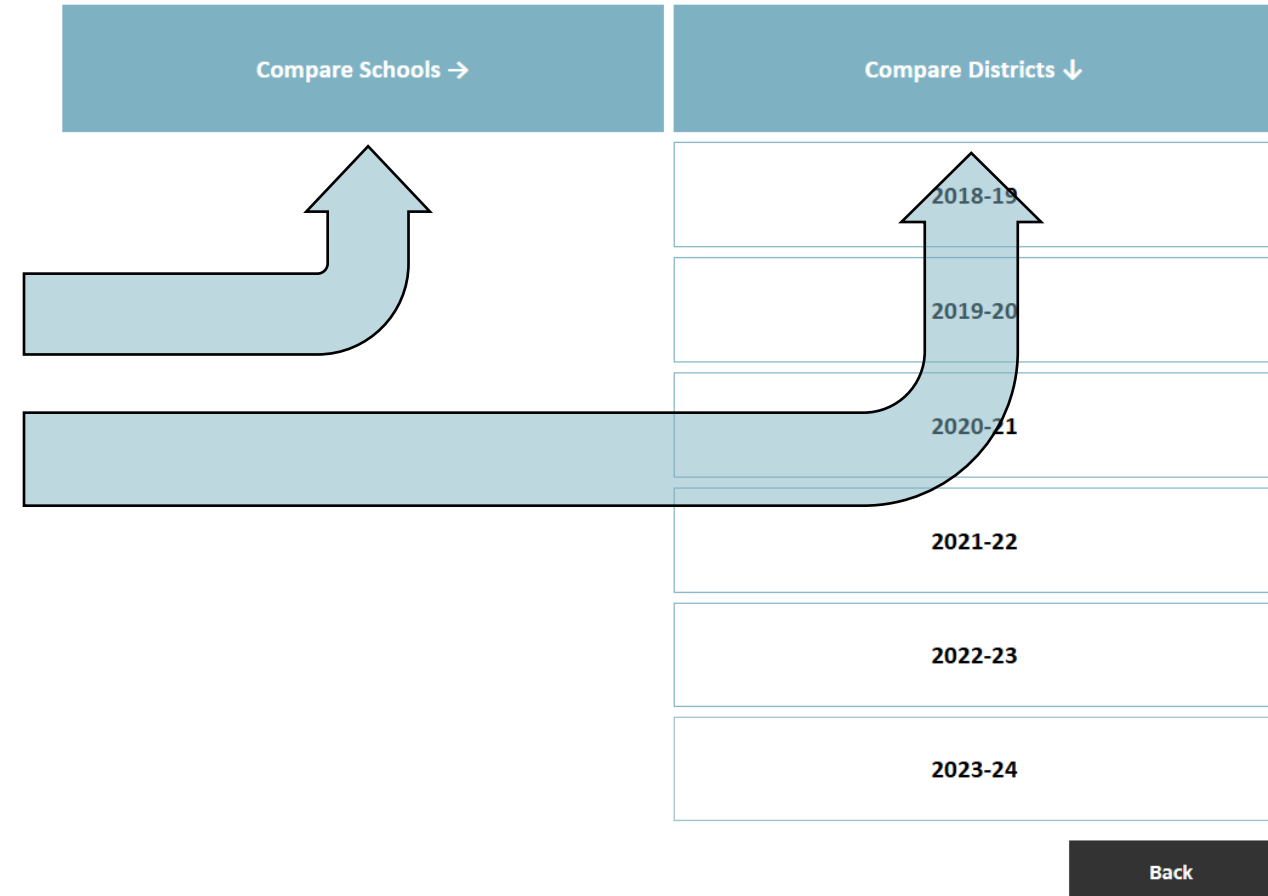
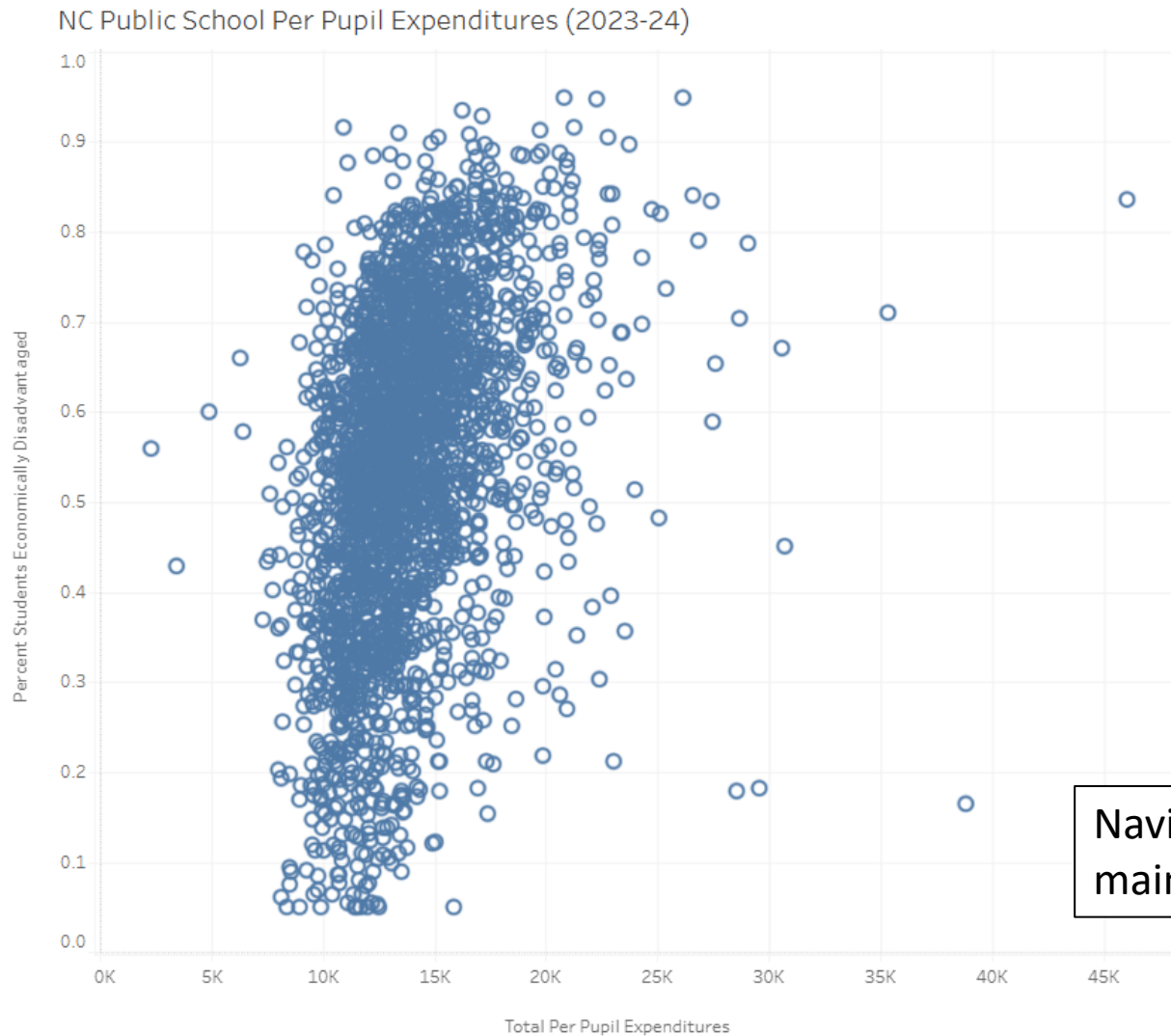


# Instructions: Compare School Spending and Student Characteristics
